

AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE (ASL)

ASL 101. Beginning American Sign Language I. (4 Credits)

Introduces cultural awareness, comprehension and production skills, and emphasizes basic sentence structure in American Sign Language with a focus on interactive communicative competence. This is a UCGS transfer course. Lecture 4 hours per week. Total 4 hours per week.

ASL 102. Beginning American Sign Language II. (4 Credits)

Introduces cultural awareness, comprehension and production skills, and emphasizes basic sentence structure in American Sign Language with a focus on interactive communicative competence. This is a UCGS transfer course. Lecture 4 hours per week. Total 4 hours per week. Prerequisites: ASL 101 or by placement test.

ASL 201. American Sign Language III. (3 Credits)

Continues to develop cultural awareness, comprehension and production skills, and emphasizes a variety of sentence structures in American Sign Language with a continued focus on interactive communicative competence. This is a UCGS transfer course. Lecture 3 hours per week. Total 3 hours per week. Prerequisite: ASL 102 or by placement test.

ASL 202. Intermediate American Sign Language II. (3 Credits)

Continues to develop cultural awareness, comprehension and production skills, and emphasizes a variety of sentence structures in American Sign Language with a continued focus on interactive communicative competence. This is a UCGS transfer course. Lecture 3 hours per week. Total 3 hours per week. Prerequisite: ASL 102 or by placement test.
